

HAILSHAM TWINNING COMMITTEE MEETING

- 1 Charter Market – Stall at C/Market worked well and many names were taken people who have shown interest in the Twinning Assoc. It was decided that this will be repeated at the next C/Market. However, would be best if a covered stall could be used. Keith to look into this. It was decided that the profile of the Twinning Association should be raised and more promotion of the benefits of twinning should be carried out.
Pauline has sent out letters to all names inviting them to the Open Meeting on 24/9. Letters have also been sent out to general members to invite them to 24/9 too.
- 2 St Claire Visit - ^ people travelled to France this year and a float was provided. It is hoped that next year at least one coach can be hired and filled. The need to decide on a theme for costumes next year was discussed. It was decided that a sub committee be formed for making plans for this event. There is a possibility of up to 20 young people also travelling over next year. It was thought that they may stay in a youth hostel near Gournay and Andy Joyes will look into this. It is hoped that the Morris Men will also be included in the visit.
- 3 Tennis Club Exchange – taking place 12-14 Sept. Paul will be hosting a family. Twinning members are invited to the Tennis Club House for a welcome drink on the French guests arrival at 5.00 pm on Friday evening. Saturday they are holding a Barn Dance in the Community Hall and are hoping that some members may attend. This was discussed and unfortunately most members were unable to attend.
- 4 Historic Society Exchange Visit – It is planned that a 3 hour visit will take on 18/10 (at 4.30) and French guests (30) will visit the Town Council Offices. It was decided that an English Cream Tea will be provided for them. Paula will be organising this and requested that at least two helpers be at hand. Other members will also be available on the day. It was also decided that the offer from Ian Price would be taken up for him to bring along some historic weapons for display etc.
- 5 Open Evening 24/9 – as mentioned above, letters have already been posted to interested parties. Membership forms will be available on the evening. Membership Under 18's free, over 18's £5 each. Membership cards will be available in the near future. Agenda decided upon – Paul to welcome and introduce committee and give a short talk, Ian to give a talk on the history of the Association.
